

The Japan Epidemiological Association (JEA) has awarded Dr Nayu Ikeda ([Section of Biostatistical Research, Center for International Collaboration and Partnership](#)) with [the Young Investigator Award for 2014](#) and [the Award of Excellence for her presentation at their 25th Annual Scientific Meeting](#) held at the Aichi Industry and Labor Center (Winc Aichi) in Nagoya on January 21–23, 2015.

Dr Ikeda gave an award lecture titled “Secondary analysis of national survey data for population health assessment” on January 22, 2015. She received an award certificate and a plaque from Professor Hiroyasu Iso (Osaka University), the president of the Japan Epidemiological Association.
